Protocol: Scalp Microneedling with Growth Factors

In-Office

- Microneedling thinning/balding scalp (depth=1.0mm)
- BM-MSC-WNT-CM Growth Factor Topical
- Every other week x 16wks (8tx's)



At-Home

- 0.2mm Dermal Stamp
- BM-MSC-CM Growth Factor Topical
- Polybotanical Topical
- Alternating every other day

- Duration: 12 weeks (28 subjects) and 24 weeks (12 subjects)
- Protocol
- Microneedling biweekly (1.0mm) with application of stem cell-derived and synthetic growth factor solution.
- Use of homecare system including growth factor and botanical formulas and dermal stamp (0.2mm)
- Hi-resolution photography, dermoscopy, and self-appraisal data collection.
- Appraisal of before and after photos by investigator





















Patient Visit - Initial Consultation INITIAL VISIT Develop rapport, convey compassion as well as willingness to help learn the "chief complaint" - what is the primary concern? What are they currently using (hair growth, hair care, etc.) Have they had previous surgery of the face or scalp (e.g. hair transplant or facelift)? Identify risk factors (meds, lifestyle, illness, stress, etc.) Overall scalp/hair health and coverage [look & feel] Assess Scalp Health (Dry, flaking, oily scalp, itch, inflammation) Assess Hair Health (Brittle, rough, dull vs. shiny, smooth) Establish baseline measurements [measure HMI] & HairCam microscope evaluation Interpretation / Assessment How do the measurements compare to "average?" How do the more permanent areas compare to affected zones? Are there areas that are severely depleted of hair?

Follow-up Visit [90 days] How long since last visit/HairCheck? Chief Complaint - "How has your hair been doing?" What treatments have you been using? How often? How long are the bottles of minoxidil lasting? How many times a week are you using your laser?



Managing Expectations

- You can NEVER regrow your 'teenage' hair
- You can NEVER resurrect dead follicles
- Treatments are designed to slow, stop and reverse the hair loss process
- Areas that have higher numbers of miniaturized hair will improve the most
- [thin hair —> thicker hair]
- Areas that are severely depleted might need transplantation









CLINICAL



The Bauman PRP Process Utilizing Emcyte PurePRP Kit

- **Step 1:** Draw 8mL of Sodium Citrate Anticoagulant into the 60 mL syringe for blood draw and 2mL of Sodium Citrate Anticoagulant into the 3mL syringe (this will be used for purging the line in step 3).
- **Step 2:** With the 60mL syringe containing Anticoagulant draw 50mL whole blood from the patient.
- Step 3: Attach the 60 ml syringe containing the anti-coagulated whole blood to the
 Concentrating Device (note: this is the device with the RED CAP) and push the entire content
 of this syringe into it. To clear the residual blood, purge the transfer line of the concentrating
 device with the 3 mL syringe containing 2mL of anticoagulant that was drawn up in Step 1.
- **Step 4:** To create a counterbalance that will be placed in the centrifuge with the Concentrating Device, use the scale provided. To do so weigh the Concentrating Device containing whole blood by placing it on the scale, press the button on the scale labeled 'TARE' and remove the concentrating device. Now place the H20 counterbalance on the scale and adjust the amount of H2O in it until it is equal to the weight of the whole blood. The scale will read zero (0).
- Step 5: Place the Concentrating Device and Counter Balance into the centrifuge (Executive Series Centrifuge), adjust the knob on the left to spin for 1.5 minutes and the knob on the right to be set at 3800 RPM's (it will read 3.8). When the first spin is completed carefully remove the device as to not disturb the separated cells.
- **Step 6:** Now that the spin is completed, using a new 60mL syringe, aspirate the platelet plasma suspension (PPS) until the RBCs fills the aspirating pipe. Stop just before the RBC's enter the syringe & remove it from the device. (RBCs should be avoided as much as possible but it's normal to aspirate *small* amounts of RBCs into the syringe during this process to ensure that all of the PPS is removed).
- **Step 7:** To initiate the second spin, transfer the platelet plasma suspension (PPS) from the 60 mL syringe into the Concentrating **Accessory.** Repeat Step 4 using the Concentrating **Accessory** to create counterbalance for this spin.

The Bauman PRP Process Utilizing Emcyte PurePRP Kit

- **Step 8:** Place Concentrating Accessory and Counter Balance into the centrifuge for 8 minutes at 3800 RPM's (it will read out as 3.8). When completed you may remove the device. In this spin, all of the platelets will concentrate and stick to the bottom of the Concentrating Accessory.
- **Step 9:** Using the 50mL syringe, aspirate the platelet poor plasma (PPP) from the Concentrating Accessory, leaving only 7mL of plasma.
- Step 10: Attach the 12mL syringe to the Concentrating accessory and gently swirl to re-suspend the platelets back into the plasma. Once the platelets have been completely re-suspended (you will no longer see them attached to the bottom), tilt the container to immerse the Aspirating Pipe into the PRP and extract into the connected 12mL syringe. (This is the primary syringe of PRP that will be injected, which can be labeled as syringe #1). To this syringe, add the thawed Bio-D Restore (extracellular matrix) and then place under the AdiLight or lor a ow level laser light source for 10 minutes.
- **Step 11:** Transfer 2mL of PPP from the 50 ml syringe into a separate 10mL syringe. This syringe will also be placed under the AdiLight or other low level light source for 10 minutes. **(this may be labeled as syringe #2, which is injected after the primary PRP has been injected).**
- **Step 12:** Once the 10 minutes is up, you will connect this syringe to a separate syringe containing 0.5 mL of Dexpanthenol and 0.2 mL of Calcium Chloride (IMPORTANT: do not mix the dexpanthnol and calcium chloride into the syringe until the time of injection as it will thicken up, making it difficult to inject).
- Step 13: Transfer 5ml of PPP from 50 mL syringe into a 5mL syringe, which will be used as a lubricant during the Micro Needling process (this can be labeled as syringe #3).

- One 60 cc syringe with 8 cc of Sodium Citrate anticoagulant

Tray B (Processing of PRP)

- Executive Series Centrifuge (Emcyte)

 - Sodium Citrate anticoagulant
 - o Filtering 18 G needle
 - Concentrating device and Concentrating accessory
 - o Two 60 cc syringes, a 50 cc syringe, a 12 cc syringe and a 3 cc syringe

Tray C (For injecting PRP)

- One bottle with 0.9% saline for irrigation
- One with 50:50 mixture of 0.9% saline for irrigation and Hydrogen Peroxide
- One antimicrobial spray bottle
- 4 x 4 Gauze
- Comb
- Two (2) dental syringes for numbing
- 6-9 Carpules of Septocaine (4% articaine solution plus Epi 1:100,000)
- Two 27g x .5" gauge needles to inject
- AmeiaMed Micro-needling device w/ sterile 6-prong tip
- AdiStem AdiLight or other low level light source

PLATELET-RICH PLASMA THERAPY BASICS: What is PRP?

- Platelet Rich Plasma or PRP is a volume of plasma of autologous blood having a platelet concentration above the baseline (baseline for platelets in a human are 150,000 350,000 platelets per microliter).
- Platelets facilitate healing by stimulating the release of different growth factors.
- The growth factors recruit stem cells that facilitate healing, repair, or regeneration of the injured tissue.
- PRP is injected directly into injured tissue stimulating a healing response in a more powerful form.

Understanding PRP


- Platelets are components of blood.
- The development of PRP focuses on concentration of the patient's own blood platelets to create an active mixture of growth factors.
- The main components of blood are Red Blood Cells, White Blood Cells, Platelets and Plasma.
- Red Blood Cells carry oxygen from the lungs and deliver it to the body tissues.
- White Blood Cells form our immune system and help the body to fight infection and foreign materials.
- Platelets have several functions, they help control bleeding (hemostasis), they help in the building of new tissue
 (act as scaffold for tissue regeneration called Extra Cellular Matrix or ECM), stem cell attraction and binding,
 without platelets undifferentiated stem cells would not know what to transform into until growth factors are
 released from the platelets, finally platelets divide, multiply and differentiate to become the healing cells for
 injured tissue.
- Platelets are activated by Thrombin and other factors which cause a change in their structure and the release of multiple growth factors.
- These growth factors bind themselves to the receptors of the cell causing intracellular changes down to the nucleus and affecting its DNA. The result is a change in the performance and function of the cell.

Application of PRP

- PRP can be used in Surgical Procedures, Orthopaedics, Spine, MSK, Pain Management, Urology, Maxillofacial, Cardio, Aesthetics and other specialties. Platelets are the natural healing element for any damaged tissue.
- Delivery of the PRP can be injected or sprayed on the injured or damaged area.
- Sodium Bicarbonate and Lidocaine are commonly used to lessen pain issues that the patient might have.
- Ultrasound and Fluoroscopy must be used in MSK or any injection of PRP where you cannot see the injured area.
 Studies have shown that using ultrasound or fluoroscopy will increase the accuracy of delivering the PRP to the injured tissue.
- Patients are asked to stop using NSAIDs two weeks prior to getting a PRP treatment.
- There are very few contraindications or risks for using autologous PRP (see table 1 below)


After-Care & Post-Procedure Instructions

Your Procedure: During your PRP Platelet Rich Plasma Hair Regrowth treatment we utilized the powerful growth factors and other proteins from your own blood platelets in a concentrated form to enhance and protect hair follicle function in the scalp. After isolating your platelets and plasma from other blood components, the concentrated PRP was enhanced with powerful Extracellular Matrix (ECM) for extra benefit and longer-lasting results. The mixture was then injected into the anesthetized target areas of the scalp and a small micro-needling device was used on the skin to trigger the release of the growth factors from the platelets. If you had the PDOgro™ procedure, absorbable PDO (polydioxanone) threads were inserted into the scalp to stimulate hair regrowth by rejuvenating weakened follicles.

Post-Treatment Care: Over the next twenty-four hours, it is normal for the scalp to appear pink or red where PRP was performed. Numbness and tingling from the local anesthesia usually wears off within 4-12 hours. The

treated area may remain slightly tender to the touch for a few days. Most normal activities-including workouts, showering, shampooing and gentle hairstyling may resume immediately. Minor swelling of the forehead may be visible one or two days after your procedure-swelling is your body's natural, expected healing response and it will typically resolve in another 24 to 48 hours. Do not apply ice. Gentle fingertip massage may be helpful.

Wait at least 24-hours before swimming and three days before using topical medications like minoxidil. Rogaine or Formula 82M Compounded Minoxidil or performing chemical hair coloring or straightening. If you had the PDOgro™ procedure, it is possible that a few of the threads may elevate to the surface of the skin. These threads may fall out on their own or you may remove them. This is not of concern as many threads have been placed during your procedure. If you experience increased pain, redness, swelling, irritation, rash, fevers, or drainage, please notify our office immediately.



PRP Platelet Rich Plasma Hair Regrowth Treatment uses the powerful growth factors found inside of your own blood platelets.

PAIN CONTROL: Unless absolutely necessary, avoid using aspirin or other "NSAID" pain medications such as Tylenol/acetaminophen, Advil/ibuprofen, Aleve/naproxen, etc. for two weeks as these medications may diminish the results of your treatment.

EXPECTED RESULTS: The powerful growth factors will start enhancing hair follicle function immediately. However, because hair growth occurs at a rate of approximately one-half inch per month, as with any treatment, improvements in hair volume and coverage may take six to twelve months to be visible in photos or to the naked eye. Please be patient as your follicles regain their health! HairCheck measurements to track your progress are recommended every ninety days, if possible. PRP treatments with ECM or PDO are typically recommended every year or two depending on your HairCheck measurements and other factors. Results can vary due to a variety of factors including age, heredity, medications, lifestyle, severity of hair loss, the amount of hair follicles located within the treated area, and other hair regrowth treatments you are using.

WHAT'S NEXT? 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Steps To Complete a HairCheck for the HairCoach

Step 1: Set up for HairCheck

NOTE: The HairCheck kit comes with all the components for performing a HairCheck except the hair clips, rattail comb, and swabs, which can be purchased a variety of stores.

- Lay out on a table or a tray the HairCheck device, HairCheck cartridges (3), glasses along with white plastic numbered tabs, ink pad and the marking template, rattail comb, clips, tape, cotton swabs with alcohol and a patient chart or other document system to record your HairCheck numbers.
- Make sure you record the date of the exam, patient's or client's name, and the initials of the persons performing the HairCheck.
- Assemble the HairCheck device by attaching the Haircheck cartridge to the device, then turn the cartridge so that it locks into place. You will hear it click.
- Place the calibration key into the slit of the cartridge and squeeze the device in the middle of the handle.
- Holding your grip on the device, you will then press the "zero" button to calibrate and gently release your grip on the handle to open the device.
- Remove the calibration key and remove the black plastic safety tab in the cartridge. Your device is now calibrated and the HairCheck device is ready to use.

Step 2: Marking the Scalp

- Part the hair of the patient down the middle of their scalp.
- Ask the patient to place the glasses on their face (place on the bridge of the nose where their glasses normally sit) and have them hold the arms of the glasses on each side so they do not come up off the bridge of their nose.
- Ensure the length of the white plastic piece (with the numbered tabs) is aligned directly down the center of the patient's head

while you identify the appropriate locations you are going to measure.

- NOTE: Since all hair loss patterns aren't the same it is important to examine the patient's hair and determine what areas should be measured. The basic areas to measure are the occipital, crown, frontal and oftentimes the temple area. The exact areas measured will vary depending on the individual's hair loss pattern.
- To mark the section for measurement, press the stamp onto the inkpad and then gently press it over the tab number selected for that area and press it into the patient's scalp making sure you can see the four pin-point markings.
- Perform the above step starting in the occipital area focusing on the most dense area as the "control" then moving forward into the crown, mid-scalp, front, and temples focusing on the least dense areas where treatment is most needed.
- Record the tab numbers in the patient's chart or paperwork.

Step 3: Measuring the Areas

- Once all of the areas to be measured have been marked, have the patient remove the glasses and begin your measurements from the back of the head towards the front.
- Upon locating the four ink dots section off the bundle of hair to measure using the rattail comb for precision. For accuracy, use the paper tape or hair clips to anchor down any hair strands *outside* of the bundle.
- Once you have the bundle of hair sectioned off, gather the bundle between your fingers. Give the bundle a slight twist to ensure you include every hair fiber within the section.
- Take the HairCheck device and slip the bundle of hair into the cartridge end and position the device so that you can visualize the HMI measurement (be able to see the read-out window of the device).
- Make sure you are measuring as close to the scalp as you can (approximately 1/4" from the scalp).



- Angle the device slightly upwards at a 45-degree angle and squeeze the handle. Let the patient know they will hear a clicking sound.
 - NOTE: The reading will display momentarily but will disappear once you release your grip on the device so remember that number!
- Record the HMI number that was displayed on the screen associated with that tab #.
- Repeat process for all areas to be measured.

Step 4: Determining Hair Mass Index (HMI)

- Determine the percentage of loss by dividing the "control" which is the largest reading that was measured (normally the occipital area but not always) into each next measurement and determine the percentage of loss.
- To calculate percentage loss: First work out the difference (decrease) between the two numbers you are comparing. Then divide the decrease by the original number and multiply the answer by 100.
- Example HairCheck:

Occipital =90

Vertex=60 \rightarrow 33% loss compared to vertex (90-60=30, then 30/90 X 100)

Frontal= $40 \rightarrow 55\%$ loss compared to vertex (90-40=50, then 50/90 X100)

• If your answer is a *negative* number then this is percentage increase. The desired goal when treating hair loss is stabilization of the process or a percentage increase in HMI. An HMI increase or stabilization (HMI remaining the same) has been seen many times upon rechecking the HMI 90 days or more post-hair regrowth treatment.

WHAT IS ADIPOSE DERIVED STEM CELL	WHAT DOES THE PROCEDURE INVOLVE?

WHAT IS ADIPOSE DERIVED STEM CELL THERAPY?

Stem cell therapy is one of the most promising treatments being used today to help patients rejuvenate and regrow hair. The use of adipose [fat] derived mesenchymal stem cells [ADSCs or MSCs] for hair growth is the newest breakthrough therapy that uses your body's own regenerative cells and fat tissue to improve, support and enhance the function of hair follicles in the scalp.

This natural, side-effect free regenerative treatment is proving to positively stimulate cellular activity, as a way to restart and enhance hair follicles to improve hair growth.

WHAT ARE ADIPOSE DERIVED STEM CELLS (ADSCS)?

Adipose derived adult stem cells have proven themselves a useful tool in tissue engineering and regenerative medical applications through their ability to repair, replenish and regenerate damaged tissue. ADSCs are mesenchymal stem cells found within body fat or "adipose" and are considered to be ideal for application in regenerative therapies - including supporting healthy hair follicles and hair regrowth.

This simple and comfortable outpatient procedure can be performed in your doctor's office. The procedure itself consists of the collection of a small adipose sample, where your body's own powerful cellular and biologic materials, called Stromal Vascular Fraction [SVF], are then separated into a concentrated form which is then carefully injected into targeted areas of the scalp.

ARE ADSC INJECTIONS MORE EFFECTIVE THAN PRP THERAPY?

While we are still studying ADSC's efficacy as a hair loss treatment, ongoing clinical trials have shown that ADSC has powerful effects on the hair growth cycle. Our experience has shown that results from ADSC can be significantly greater than PRP, meaning it has the potential to help hair loss sufferers as a stand-alone therapy as well as a tool to help support successful hair transplant results.

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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ADIPOSE DERIVED STEM CELLS (ADSC)

SHOULD I USE ADSC AS A STAND-ALONE TREATMENT OR IN COMBINATION WITH OTHER THERAPIES?

In many cases, a multi-therapy approach is most effective in treating hair loss. ADSC may be used as an adjunct to FDA-approved medications or other therapies like low level laser therapy, nutritional supplementation and hair transplantation.

Whether used on its own or in conjunction with another treatment, ADSC's primary objective is to support hair follicle function, fight the progression of hair loss and enhance hair growth.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT FROM ADSC THERAPY?

Stem cell therapy will start enhancing and/or protecting hair follicle function immediately.

However, keep in mind, hair grows slowly, and at different rates for different people. As with all hair growth treatments, it can take several months before results are measurable,

Improvements in hair volume and coverage may take six to 12 months to be visibly noticeable. Therefore, Bauman Medical recommends a complete hair loss consultation and examination with HairCheck measurements to establish a baseline before beginning an ADSC therapy regimen.

WHAT IS THE RECOVERY TIME AFTER ADSC THERAPY?

ADSC hair growth treatment is a quick outpatient procedure that takes approximately one hour to perform. Patients can resume activity following the procedure but should avoid strenuous activity for one week. The abdominal compression garment should be worn snuggly for four days following treatment.

IS ADSC THERAPY RIGHT FOR ME?

Unfortunately, in our experience, not all patients are good candidates for ADSC injection treatments, so please contact the office for a consultation to see if you are a candidate.

The first step is to schedule a consultation where our team will be able to diagnose your situation, identify hair loss risk factors and discuss the best treatment plan to address your specific hair restoration goals. Our team will work with you to determine your specific needs and goals and create an individualized multi-therapy treatment plan that will optimize your results.

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Laser procedures can comfortably and effectively transform your skin in just a few treatments. Aesthetic laser procedures include:

- Laser Hair Removal
- Removal of unwanted pigment
- Vein and redness reduction
- Wrinkle reduction
- Nail fungus treatment

LASER HAIR REMOVAL

How does laser hair removal work?

The laser beam travels through the skin and targets the pigment within the hair follicle to inhibit further growth. Thus, the darker the hair, the easier that it will be to remove. The results are permanent.

How many treatments are needed, and how long do they take?

Because hair grows in cycles, it generally takes at least four treatments spaced 4-8 weeks apart for optimal results. Depending on the size of the treatment area, the procedure takes anywhere between 5-30 minutes.

Is laser hair removal painful?

No. The Clarity laser that is used at Bauman Medical emits a cryogenic spray with each laser pulse. This cools the skin and makes the procedure very comfortable, unlike other laser hair removal devices.

Is it safe for my skin type, and will it work on my color hair?

Laser hair removal can be safely achieved for all skin types with the Clarity laser. Darker hair is most easily removed, but vellus hair removal can be achieved as well.

UNWANTED PIGMENT REMOVAL

What types of pigment can be treated?

Age spots, freckles, birthmarks, benign pigmented lesions, sebhorreic keratosis, and sun damage.

What is the treatment like?

The discomfort level is very mild but varies depending on the treatment area and takes only about ten minutes. The number of sessions required depends on the area to be treated and type of pigment being removed.

When will I see results?

The area treated may actually become darker during the first ten days post-procedure, but it will become noticeably lighter in the weeks that follow.

What types of vascular conditions can be treated with laser therapy?

Rosacea, facial veins, spider veins, broken capillaries, hemangiomas, and other vascular lesions that occur from sun damage, genetics, and aging.

When laser energy is absorbed by the blood vessels it converts to heat, thereby reducing or eliminating their appearance.

What is the treatment like?

When will I see results?

While some veins may take some time to be broken down by the body, others will disappear immediately.

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Because eyebrows are so prominent in our facial expressions, it's usually very easy to notice when their appearance is impacted by scars, illness or age. Fortunately, modern extraction and implantation technology allows us to transplant healthy, growing hair follicles permanently into the brow to restore or augment your natural look.

While this technique is ideal for patients who have empty patches or sparseness due to aging, overplucking, injury or burns, and it can also be used to cosmetically augment eyebrows and enhance the brow's shape.

WHO IS A CANDIDATE FOR EYEBROW TRANSPLANTATION?

In both men and women, aging can cause eyebrows to noticeably thin and lose the fullness and density that is associated with youth. Similarly, scars from burns or other injuries can create bare patches that can be restored with transplantation. It is not uncommon for us to treat patients who have already attempted to augment or restore their eyebrows with permanent makeup (tattooing) and are looking to enhance their results. Transplanting into these tattoos not only adds a needed "3rd dimension" to the eyebrows, but the underlying tattoo can often make the transplanted brow appear fuller.

Those who have eyebrows that have been damaged by physical trauma, burns, age, illness or have been successfully treated for the compulsive hair-pulling disease trichotillomania, are usually viable candidates for this procedure. However, those with active eyebrow *trichotillomania* may not undergo the procedure as pulling/plucking can cause damage to the transplanted brows. Further, patients suffering from alopecia totalis, alopecia universalis, or have active eyebrow inflammation are not candidates for eyebrow transplantation.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

The procedure is performed in-office under comfortable computerized local anesthesia. Hair follicles are harvested from a donor site in the back of the scalp. Harvested follicles are then carefully implanted into the brow area one by one, with care taken to match the normal angles, patterns and density so that a truly natural look can be achieved.

Typically, all transplantation is performed in a single session, although some patients may require an additional session to achieve their desired result. Transplanted follicles will require about a week to heal and will lay dormant for a few months before beginning to grow and produce hair permanently. Once hair begins growing from the transplanted follicles, it will need to be routinely trimmed, just as it would on the scalp.

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WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT EYEBROW TRANSPLANTATION

IS IT PAINFUL?

Performed under local anesthetic, the procedure itself is virtually painless, and carried out while the patient is awake with mild sedation. Patients are instructed to arrange transportation to and from the office rather than driving themselves.

Once the local anesthetic wears off a few hours after surgery, patients can expect to experience some mild soreness on both the brow and the donor site, for which pain relief medication is provided. Some minor crusts, swelling, and/or bruising may also occur around the brow and/or eyelid, and typically lasts less than a week. Makeup in the eyebrow area should be avoided for the first 4-5 days following the procedure.

Hair will typically begin to grow in 6-12 weeks, with noticeable results in as little as 4 months and a full cosmetic result in approximately 10-12 months.

WHAT ARE THE RISKS?

As with any cosmetic procedure, there are always risks to consider. Known risks of eyebrow implantation are mild, rare, and considered similar to those associated with any hair transplant surgery. These depend on a number of factors, such as the number of follicles being implanted and the overall health of the patient. Bauman Medical recommends that patients discuss all potential risks and concerns about this or any other surgery with their doctor prior to beginning treatment.

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Thanks to modern advancements in extraction and implantation technology, it is possible to transplant healthy, growing hair follicles permanently into the eyelid to restore or augment existing eyelashes.

Generally, this specialized technique was used for patients who have missing eyelashes due to injury or burns, but recently there has been a dramatic increase in demand to cosmetically enhance sparse or "weak" eyelashes.

WHO IS A CANDIDATE FOR EYELASH TRANSPLANTATION?

Those who have eyelashes that have been damaged by physical trauma, burns, eyelash extensions, or have been successfully treated for the compulsive hair-pulling disease trichotillomania, are usually viable candidates for this procedure. However, those with active eyelash trichotillomania may not undergo the procedure as pulling/plucking can cause damage to the transplanted lashes. Further, patients suffering from alopecia totalis, alopecia universalis, or have active eyelid inflammation are not candidates for eyelash transplantation.

Note: For safety reasons, eyelash transplantation is only performed on the upper eyelid.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

The procedure is performed in-office under local anesthesia. Hair follicles are harvested from a discreet donor site (typically in the back of the scalp), and then precision-implanted into the upper eyelid. Approximately 60-90 lashes can be implanted within a single session per lid, which lasts about 2-4 hours. Absorbable stitches are used on the donor site, which will remain undetectable both during and after the healing process, which lasts about 2-3 weeks.

WHEN WILL TRANSPLANTED LASHES GROW?

Transplanted lashes typically shed within 2 weeks after implantation, and will begin to regrow at about 6-12 weeks post-procedure. Usually, about 90% of transplanted eyelashes will grow, and a complete cosmetic result can be expected within 12 months.

It's important to note that transplanted follicles are not the same as your body's eyelash follicles. While standard eyelash follicles grow hairs that only reach a certain length, transplanted follicles will continue to grow just as they would have in their original location, so lashes will need to be trimmed and curled regularly.

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WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT EYELASH TRANSPLANTATION

IS IT PAINFUL?

A comfortable, computer-assisted local anesthetic, and a mild sedative are both administered prior to the procedure. Additionally, medications to ease mild discomfort and to reduce inflammation in treated areas are administered postoperatively. Several hours after the procedure, some soreness may be experienced in either the donor area or eyelids, or both. This will usually subside within 24 to 48 hours.

WHAT IS THE DOWNTIME?

Patients are advised to wear the provided protective goggles while sleeping for the first few nights. Patients will likely experience some crusting and bruising in the eyelid area during the first week. Patients may not use mascara or any other eye makeup within the first 10 days following the procedure. Sunglasses may be worn during this time.

Finally, the absorbable stitches used in the donor site at the back of the scalp may several weeks to dissolve completely.

WHAT ARE THE RISKS?

As with any cosmetic procedure, there are always both known and unknown risks to consider. Known risks of eyelash implantation are considered similar and equal to those associated with any minor eyelid surgery, and depend on a number of factors, such as the number of lashes being implanted, and the overall health of the patient. Bauman Medical recommends that patients discuss all potential risks and concerns about this or any other surgery with their doctor prior to beginning treatment.

WHAT IS FUE?

Dating as far back as the 1950s, hair transplants have traditionally relied upon harvesting hair follicles from the scalp by cutting out large plugs or strips and then grafting them onto the scalp where needed. This often resulted in slow-healing, discomfort, poor growth, scars and results that appeared less than natural.

In 2001, a microsurgical procedure called FUE, or "Follicular Unit Extraction" was pioneered in the U.S., allowing hair follicle grafts to be harvested individually, and then transplanted to create truly natural looking hairlines without linear scarring. Dr. Alan Bauman was one of the first hair transplant specialists to adopt and master, as well as help teach and train, the nuances of this technique. His early experience led him to design the first commercially-available manual instrument specifically for FUE as well as correctly predict that patient-demand for FUE would overtake more traditional invasive hair transplant techniques.

THE FUE REVOLUTION

New advancements in FUE techniques and technology-including robotics and artificial intelligence-have dramatically improved the speed and accuracy of hair follicle extraction for a huge variety of skin and hair types. This speed and precision translates to fewer, shorter, more effective transplant procedures to accomplish your overall hair restoration goals.

WHO IS A GOOD CANDIDATE FOR FUE?

The procedure is unrivaled for those who prefer short haircuts or wish to have the least amount of activity restriction after their transplant procedure, such as athletes or active adults. The FUE technique is also excellent at camouflaging old scars, touching up hairlines, restoring facial hair and eyebrows, and even harvesting body hair follicles for transplantation for those who have limited scalp donor hair. An initial medical hair loss evaluation and consultation is needed to determine if you are a good candidate

WHAT MAKES FUE DIFFERENT FROM OTHER TRANSPLANT OPTIONS?

The difference is in the extraction. Follicular Unit Extraction allows patients to avoid the telltale linear scarring and additional activity-restricted healing time required with traditional strip harvesting methods. Because the less-invasive FUE approach harvests follicles individually without a scalpel and stitches or staples, the donor area in the back of the head heals faster, requires less downtime and can be more easily camouflaged with shorter haircuts in the long run.

WHAT ARE THE DRAWBACKS OF FUE?

In the proper hands, the only drawback is the potentially longer duration of the FUE procedure compared to other techniques. Since each delicate follicular unit graft is individually harvested and implanted, FUE requires an experienced team in order to ensure that the

highest rate of viable grafts are successfully obtained, preserved and transplanted, all while ensuring your remaining donor hair follicles are unharmed. Of course, the final aesthetic outcome of any hair transplant is determined by the artistic skill of the surgeon.

DO I HAVE TO SHAVE MY ENTIRE HEAD?

No. While close trimming of the donor hair is required for harvesting, there is usually no need to trim or shave the area where follicles are being implanted.

FROM WHERE ARE THE FOLLICLES HARVESTED?

Typically, healthy and relatively permanent hair follicles are harvested from the donor area on the sides and back of your head. Not only is this the most discreet area, it is also the most likely to yield an abundance of healthy follicles that will continue to grow hair and stay with you for life! For those with limited donor hair in the scalp, FUE techniques can be used to harvest body hair if available (e.g., beard, chest, abdomen, and even back, arms and legs for transplantation to the scalp and other areas.

DOES IT HURT? HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO HEAL?

Level of discomfort during and after a minimallyinvasive FUE procedure is extremely low and many times non-existent. Healing ability is different in each patient, and can vary with different treatments as well. Usually, our FUE procedures are accompanied with PRP or Platelet Rich Plasma, laser therapy and other treatments that will significantly accelerate healing time. Generally, crusting in the extraction or donor area lasts only a few days, and complete healing in the implanted or recipient area takes less than two weeks.

WILL IT LOOK NATURAL? WHAT ARE THE MOST IMPORTANT FACTORS IN FUE TRANSPLANTS?

That's simple. It's artistry and experience. The true measure of any transplant is the surgeon's skill in crafting a natural looking result. This requires matching the natural location, density and angle of transplanted follicles so that the hair grows out as it should. Dedication to the artistry of hairline reconstruction is the difference between an undetectable result and looking like you've had a hair transplant. Fortunately, you are in excellent hands. Dr. Bauman has performed thousands of procedures on both men and women, has transplanted millions of FUE grafts, and is considered one of the foremost medical experts in FUE worldwide.

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WHAT IS LOW-LEVEL LASER THERAPY?

Providing energy to hair follicles, getting them to grow a thicker, healthier hair has gotten easier and more efficient with the advent of more powerful, more convenient, cordless and rechargeable FDA-cleared laser therapy devices. Many of today's top practitioners rely on drug-free laser therapy with or without other treatments to provide optimum hair regrowth for both male and female patients.

HOW DOES LASER THERAPY FOR HAIR REGROWTH WORK?

With FDA clearances and strong clinical evidence to support its efficacy as a hair loss treatment, today low level lasers have become an important tool for those seeking to restore their locks. But how exactly do these lasers help you fight hair loss?

Laser therapy for hair growth utilizes wavelengths of light in the "visible red" part of the spectrum which have a biological effect on cells. It is known that wavelengths of light produced by the diodes of the lasers are associated with an increase in energy production [ATP] within the cells, which may be a primary mechanism for helping a follicle to grow better hair by producing thicker, longer, healthier looking hair strands. Since their discovery in the 1960s, low-level lasers have been proven to be an effective drug-free and side effect-free way to help heal wounds, relieve pain, increase circulation, and decrease inflammation. Today, low level laser treatments are delivered using a baseball style cap called a Lasercap.

HOW OFTEN SHOULD I WEAR MY LASER THERAPY CAP?

Recommended treatments may vary based on each patient's specific needs and goals and the device used.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OVER HAND-HELD LASER THERAPY DEVICES?

Unlike laser 'combs' and 'brushes', Laser Therapy Caps offer a discreet, hands-free treatment to the scalp, allowing patients to easily work their therapy sessions into their daily routines. These lasers can fit into most hats, and can also be hidden under a scarf or bandana, or used on its own without a hat.

CAN I COMBINE LASER THERAPY WITH MY OTHER TREATMENTS?

Absolutely. While Laser Therapy can be used as a stand-alone treatment, many patients maximize its effectiveness by adding it to a multi-therapy treatment plan. Hair transplant patients often use Laser Therapy to help accelerate healing and decrease discomfort after surgery.

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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS LASER THERAPY CAP

ARE YOU A GOOD CANDIDATE FOR A LASER THERAPY CAP?

For those with hair loss or hair thinning, keep in mind, these may be influenced by many factors including heredity, medications, illness, stress, nutrition, lifestyle, etc., and left untreated only gets worse with time. Because so many factors can influence ones hair loss status, it is essential to undergo a thorough medical consultation with a specialist before initiating any hair restoration regimen. Baseline evaluations, tracking measurements and standardized medical photos are critical to provide an objective measurement of your progress. Laser therapy can add a nonchemical side effect-free treatment to your hair growth regimen.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF LASERCAP?

Consistent use of low-level laser therapy treats hair loss, hair thinning, and has been proven to improve the appearance of hair quality, hair strength and hair thickness. The lasercap will also in addition, promote hair growth. Clinical studies have shown a 51% increase in terminal (healthy) hair counts on patients when compared to those using placebo devices. There has never been a reported side effect of low-level laser therapy since its use began in the 1960s. Since laser devices are durable and long lasting with proper care, a good-quality Laser Therapy device may be your least costly treatment over time.

WHAT KIND OF RESULTS CAN I EXPECT WITH LASER THERAPY?

Laser therapy, like other non-invasive hair growth treatments, is not a "miracle cure," but it can be an important treatment for damaged hair, thinning hair and hair loss. While low-level laser therapy does facilitate hair growth, it is important to understand that it doesn't regrow hair that is already dead and gone, which is why early detection and intervention is essential for optimal results. Laser therapy can jumpstart areas where the hair is thinning and can also be effective for hair growth when used in combination with other medical treatments like compounded topical minoxidil, oral finasteride, platelet-rich plasma plus stem cell injections, prostaglandin analogs, nutritional supplements and hair transplant surgery, either with SmartGraft FUE, NeoGraft FUE or the ARTAS Robotic-Assisted FUE Hair Transplant System.

As with any hair growth treatment, early results are subtle and full, final results take time. To track your progress and stay consistent with the treatment, Bauman Medical recommends getting baseline hair measurements with HairCheck before starting laser therapy so you can know what areas are receiving a benefit and how much improvement is occurring.

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PDOgro[™] is a promising new lunchtime treatment that was recently pioneered by Dr. Alan J Bauman and introduced in the US. It is currently being used exclusively by Bauman Medical to stimulate hair regrowth.

WHAT PDOgro™?

PDOgro™ thread insertion procedure is an exciting new, non-invasive treatment to stimulate hair regrowth. PDO (polydioxanone) is a commonly used slowly absorbing synthetic surgical suture material that stimulates collagen production, elastin, and hyaluronic acid as well as activates fibroblasts while it dissolves. These FDA-cleared PDO sutures have been used safely in surgery for decades and, in recent years, have shown promise in aesthetic medicine for skin rejuvenation including tightening, lifting, and wrinkle reduction.

HOW DOES PDOgro™ WORK AS A HAIR LOSS TREATMENT?

Dr. Bauman's unique application of the PDO threads, PDOgro™, is performed under painless local anesthesia by aseptically inserting PDO MasterThreads into the scalp in the thinning areas to stimulate hair regrowth by rejuvenating weakened follicles. This proprietary process is currently the only procedure in the U.S. using PDO threads for hair regrowth.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT FROM A PDOgro™ TREATMENT?

This painless "lunchtime" procedure is believed to stimulate hair regrowth through the release of

growth factors and increased blood flow in the treatment area. The material slowly and safely dissolves over a period of months. This outpatient non-surgical treatment requires no recovery, no downtime, no aftercare, and no activity restrictions.

WHO CAN IT HELP?

PDO sutures have been used in various medical and surgical applications for decades, but the hair restoration field is just tapping into its potential as a hair loss treatment. Current research supports its use for stopping, slowing or reversing hair loss and promoting hair regrowth. Research has shown that PDOgro™ can be used as a stand-alone hair growth treatment or in conjunction with FDA-approved medications, low-level laser therapy, as well as other procedures including PRP, other cell therapy treatments and hair transplantation.

HOW OFTEN WILL I NEED TO BE TREATED?

Every patient responds to treatment differently. HairCheck hair regrowth measurements are recommended every three months to track improvements in hair growth and to help determine when the next PDOgro™ thread treatment is indicated. This continued monitoring of progress will generally show an increase in hair growth within three to six months and normally taking six or more months before the effects of treatment are visually noticeable. However, some patients have responded more quickly.

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PDOgroTM PROCEDURE

DOES PDOgro™ GROW "NEW" HAIR FOLLICLES?

No - at this time, your body cannot grow new hair follicles. However, PDOgro™ has been shown to be effective at helping to stimulate hair follicles to grow thicker, stronger, longer and more pigmented hairs--producing increased volume and coverage in thinning zones.

CAN PDOgro™ BE COMBINED WITH OTHER TREATMENTS AND PROCEDURES LIKE HAIR TRANSPLANTATION?

Yes, absolutely. As in many areas of medicine, a multimodality or multitherapy approach can work synergistically to bring a stronger therapeutic result. Treatments like PRP, laser therapy, custom-compounded topical minoxidil, and other interventions can be combined with PDO thread insertion. Transplanted hair is relatively permanent, but your other hair is not, so PDOgro™ can be used to help protect hair follicle function in thenon-transplanted hair. PDOgro™ can be comfortably performed at the time of your hair transplant procedure.

LOOKING AHEAD


Although initial research and results have been presented at major medical conferences, continued research and studies are being conducted to help unlock PDOgroTM's maximum potential for hair loss patients. Clinical trials at Bauman Medical will help determine how long the hair growth improvements with PDO threads willast as a stand-alone treatment, as well as in conjunction with other treatments.

AM I A GOOD CANDIDATE FOR PDOgro™?

PDOgro™, like many other non-invasive treatments, are best applied at the earliest phases of hair thinning, while there is a good chance to help preserve and enhance hair follicle function. A video or in-person consultation with PDOgro™ pioneer and ABHRS certified Hair Restoration Physician, Dr. Alan J. Bauman is recommended before proceeding with any medical treatment for hair loss.

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WHAT IS PLATELET-RICH PLASMA (PRP)?

Platelet-Rich Plasma (PRP) is a source of your own natural growth factors that stimulate tissue regeneration and hair growth. This is a highly effective treatment that is widely used in orthopedics, oral maxillofacial surgery, cosmetic surgery, and other medical disciplines as a surgery alternative that promotes healing, repair, and rejuvenation. Perhaps most remarkably, however, is that the PRP used to treat you is produced from your own blood.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Once a small sample of your blood is drawn, a special process separates its various components to produce the concentrated PRP. The processed PRP is applied to desired areas virtually painlessly and then activated to begin stimulating hair growth. Blood platelets represent our bodies' own remarkable healing power, and when applied correctly, this power can also stimulate and enhance hair growth.

This non-invasive procedure takes little more than an hour and is often called the "lunchtime treatment" for hair loss.

PRP can be performed as a stand-alone procedure, in addition to other medical and non-medical therapies, or also in conjunction with a hair transplant procedure to increase its effectiveness and improve outcomes. A medical hair loss evaluation is required to determine if you are an appropriate candidate for PRP treatments.

DOES PRP GROW "NEW" HAIR FOLLICLES?

No - your body cannot grow new hair follicles, but PRP has been proven effective at helping to stimulate weak hair follicles. PRP also protects and rejuvenates your hair by growing longer, thicker, more pigmented hair from follicles affected by hair loss.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT DURING A PRP TREATMENT?

From a patient's perspective, the procedure is quick, comfortable and relatively simple to undergo. A small sample of your blood is drawn and then processed under physician supervision in sterile conditions with special equipment to prepare the PRP. It is then painlessly applied into the desired area of your scalp, which has been cleansed and treated with a local anesthetic prior to the procedure. A special FDA-cleared microneedling device is used to spur the platelets into action to complete the activation of the release of powerful growth factors.

PRP:PLATELET RICH PLASMA

IS THERE ANY DOWNTIME AFTER A PRP PROCEDURE?

Afterwards, other than some temporary redness of the skin in the treated area, there are no signs at all that the treatment has been performed. There are NO activity restrictions following treatment, and patients may shampoo their hair immediately afterwards.

WHAT ARE THE RISKS?

Since the Platelet-Rich Plasma is derived from your own blood, the treatment is already perfectly suited to your body's own chemistry and processes. This insulates it against disease transmission, cellular rejection and other concerns, making the procedure extremely safe and relatively free from all risks.

Assuming you are considered a good candidate for PRP therapy to begin with, risks are minimal. Even the need for post-treatment pain medication is rare because of the local anesthesia used during the procedure.

HOW OFTEN WILL I NEED TO BE TREATED?

Every patient responds to treatment differently. However, continual monitoring of your progress with HairCheck® measurement tools will generally show an increase in hair growth within three to six months, taking six months to a year before the effects of a treatment are visually noticeable. The measurements will also help determine when a repeat treatment is needed. Due to the use of Dr. Bauman's unique protocol, results may last one to two years with a single application.

IS ALL PRP THE SAME?

Sadly, no. Most practitioners do not use sophisticated preparation protocols to adequately concentrate the blood platelets, neglect to perform measurements to check progress, or utilize protocols that prolong PRP effects. If your practitioner suggests a "series" of treatments over several months, this usually indicates a lack of sophistication in the PRP preparation and application protocol. Seek out a specialist who exclusively treats hair loss and performs scientific measurements before and after treatment.

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THE RECRUITER FOR STEM CELL SUPPORT:

The Recruiter is a first-of-its-kind daily supplement for optimum health, overall longevity and anti-aging, and recovery from injury. It is often used before and after hair transplants, PRP, and PDOgro™ to promote healing for faster recovery and improved hair growth results.

BACKGROUND:

Stem cells in the body are responsible for tissue regeneration and repair, and the medical significance of circulating stem cells is becoming increasingly recognized. Augmentation of circulating stem cells using cell therapy and medications has resulted in promising preclinical and clinical data for numerous degenerative conditions.

However, this approach is limited by cost, adverse events, as well as barriers to chronic administration--including the need for complex cell processing facilities only available at a limited number of medical institutions. WHAT IS ALMA TED?

Alma TED, or Trans-Epidermal Delivery, is a revolutionary pain-free, needle-free, in-office hair restoration treatment with no recovery or downtime. Bauman Medical is among the first clinic in the world offering this exciting new therapy for hair loss, hair thinning, and hair shedding.

HOW DOES TED WORK?

TED is a safe, ultrasound-based treatment that uses sound waves and air pressure to enhance the penetration of a specialized topical hair growth formula into the scalp. This treatment increases blood flow, optimizes scalp health, and stimulates hair follicles to produce thicker, stronger, healthier hair. TED offers these benefits without the discomfort of injections or temporary shedding associated with some in-office hair growth treatments.

WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT?

TED is a quick 20-25 minute treatment that can often be performed the same day as your consultation. Please keep in mind our comprehensive consultations take approximately one hour. During your consultation, Dr. Bauman or another member of our medical team will evaluate and diagnose your hair loss situation, perform baseline measurements, and determine whether you are a good candidate for Alma TED and/or other hair restoration therapies.

DOES TED REGROW A NEW HAIR FOLLICLE?

Unfortunately, no. The only way to restore hair growth to a severely depleted area is through hair transplantation. However, TED can be used in conjunction with hair transplants to heal the scalp faster, grow the transplanted hair sooner, and also help slow, stop, and reverse the progression of hair loss in non-transplanted areas.

IS THE TREATMENT PAINFUL?

No, the treatment is quite comfortable. You can expect to feel a vibration and a warm sensation from the device on the scalp during treatment. There is absolutely no pain involved. Patients find the procedure relaxing, and many fall asleep during their procedure. No needles or anesthesia is required. Because there is no trauma to the scalp, there is absolutely no discomfort afterward. It is normal for the scalp to appear slightly pink for about an hour after TED treatment.

WHO IS A GOOD CANDIDATE FOR TED?

Alma TED may be used on any individual that is suffering from hair shedding, hair thinning or hair loss or wants to improve the overall thickness and appearance of their hair. Many patients see less shedding after just a single TED treatment.

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HOW DOES TED COMPARE TO PRP, PDOGRO, OR OTHER NON-SURGICAL/NON-INVASIVE REGENERATIVE TREATMENTS?

It's important to know that every patient is an individual, and there is no "one size fits all" therapy. PRP and PDOgro™ at Bauman Medical are typically once-a-year treatments, whereas TED would require a series of four treatments spaced one month apart. Measurements are used in every case to measure the response to treatment in several areas of the scalp. Some areas may respond better to different types of therapy. Here at Bauman Medical, we offer a variety of non-surgical and surgical treatment options, many of which may be combined with TED.

HOW CAN I SCHEDULE TED?
